Hotel Le Fabe

A charming hotel because it only consists of 17 rooms, Le Fabe has a friendly and personal touch to the service.



Hotel Le Fabe, Paris' latest boutique hotel, was started by four friends who had previously worked in catering, the hotel business and engineering, but who have a passion for the hotel industry that led them to go at it on their own.

Le Fabe is situated in Pernety, a previously run-down area close to Montparnasse that has reinvented itself and now has a number of nice restaurants and a relaxed vibe.

Formerly a one-star hotel, it has been extensively refurbished and redesigned and is now a stylish and friendly three-star establishment.



The hotel itself features 17 rooms, divided into three types: Cosy - the smallest rooms, Charm - regular rooms, and Plaisir - large double rooms. All rooms have large pictures over the beds, which influence the colour schemes used. There are no room numbers, instead rooms have names inspired by the pictures inside - such as 'Désir', 'Passion' and 'Orchidees'.

The elegant bedrooms are decorated in mainly sombre, inviting colours, with the picture motifs also used on chairs. Bathrooms are tiled and have a grey/white colour theme and luxurious handwash and shampoo. WGSN loved the large bathroom and the beds in the Plaisir rooms.
